

HAUNTED TUNNEL APPLICATION ONLY

Daggett Farm was created not only as an added attraction to Slater Memorial Park but has also served as an educational tool for the community. Many of the costs needed to maintain or provide improvements to this Farm and its animals are met by the revenue raised through the dedication and volunteering efforts from the Haunted Tunnel.

Volunteers are needed for the annual Daggett Farm Haunted Tunnel event in Slater Park. The group starts in September constructing and creating the attraction. The Tunnel is then open to the public every Friday and Saturday throughout October. The doors are open to the public at 6:30pm and will close approximately at 8:30pm to allow for the patrons to have access prior to 9:00pm and to begin clean-up.

By agreeing to participate, it is expected that you will assist your fellow team-mates throughout the construction and dismantling process. Times and dates will be announced. If you are unable to commit entirely, please let us know your availability as all help is greatly appreciated and we can schedule you accordingly. Incentives are given and are based upon the level of commitment of each volunteer.

Planning and participation are key to the success of this popular attraction.

- **Volunteer opportunities (not limited to scaring but that is the fun part!!!):**
 - **Construction, lighting, set design, security, actors**
 - **PARENTS ARE WELCOME TO HELP!!**
- **September:** Construction of the Tunnel grounds (times and dates will be coordinated). Follow the **“Slater Park Haunted Tunnel” page for continued updates.**
- **THE FRIGHT NIGHT EVENT**
 - **October 4, 5, 11, 12, 18, 19, 25, and 26th**
 - All volunteers will arrive at Slater Park between 5:45 and 6 pm. Volunteers are responsible for setting up their respective stations and must be ready for patrons promptly at 6 pm. Volunteers must be committed for the entire evening (unless an emergency arises).
 - **FOR OPENING NIGHT**, we will need volunteers to be at the farm/carousel by **5:30pm** to receive an overview of rules and regulations. Volunteers are welcome to come early and assist with nightly preparations prior to opening.
 - We ask you to provide your own mask and/or costume. If you cannot afford one or the other, you can borrow one that is available (signing in and out for use of such items are required by whoever is using them).
 - **Costumes should be completely original and not movie-based characters.** Please be creative!!!

FRIGHT NIGHT - APPLICATION – 15 years +

- You must be 17 years or older to be able to volunteer **inside** the Tunnel. Volunteers who are ages 15-16 can still lead tunnel customers to the tunnel doors as well as other areas throughout the grounds outside of the Tunnel.
- **IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE FINAL SATURDAY NIGHT:** The dismantling and clean-up processes begin. The timeframe depends upon participation to complete the entire task.

For the volunteers:

- **There will be refreshments provided to all the working volunteers at the end of each evening. Lunch/dinner will be made available to volunteers during other times when work is being completed.**
- Participants who attend at least 8 events (including set-up and clean-up) are given an exclusive Haunted Tunnel t-shirt during our final night of festivities.
- **Additional incentives are provided for those who commit to the Tunnel season**, as well to those who are in attendance to assist at the end of the season.
- A letter will be written on your behalf, outlining the community service hours you have provided the City of Pawtucket, upon request. Neither the Tunnel, nor the City of Pawtucket, provide court-mandated community service. Please be sure to clarify if the letter is intended for a specific organization.
- Please contact me directly if your work or non-profit organization is interested as community outreach participation.

Volunteers (18 years of age & older) ***RESPONSIBLE ADULTS ARE NEEDED***

- Must fill out a “City of Pawtucket – Volunteer Application”
- Must fill out a “Haunted Tunnel Application”
- **A copy of license must be submitted with application**
- **A completed “Authority for Release of Information” form for BCI check is required** for those 18 years of age or older

All 4 items must be submitted to the Slater Park Office
